NAEP tests 12 <sup>th</sup> graders at selected schools.	F) Both English-only and English-Spanish formats are available. ( Braille interface is available in English only.)
B) Required test for students in grades 3 through 8 and in High School. See Section 5.2 for specific local test window criteria. Grade 12 students may take the ELA and Mathematics assessments for Essential Skills or college placement purposes.	G) Oregon Extended tests requiring Braille or Large Print format must be ordered during the order window.
C) Required test for students in grades 5, 8, and in High School.	H) Available for download starting one week before the start of the test window, on 2/8/18.
D) Optional test for students in grades 5, 8, and in High School.	I) If the data entry (or shipping) deadline is missed, students will be counted as non-participants.
