OVERVIEW OF STUDENT/FAMILY OPTIONS DURING MANDATED SCHOOL CLOSURE

K-5 COMPREHENSIVE DISTANCE LEARNING PLAN—more info: <https://pendleton.k12.or.us/2020/08/03/letter-to-parents-2/>

- Students remain with and instruction provided by their in-building classroom teacher.
- Students will have live interactive teacher led lessons daily, the same live lesson will be available in the morning and afternoon to allow flexibility to parents and students.
- Lessons will be recorded and available for watching at a later time to allow flexibility.
- Instruction will happen Monday through Friday.
- Teachers will be available to parents and students via phone or email during from 7:45-8:30am and 10:30am-12:45pm.
- Student work and deadlines are the same as if holding on-site classes. Some lessons may be modified due to the online platform but parents can expect rigor and expectations equal to the on-site classroom.
- Students will use Google Classroom and Google Meets for classes and lessons.
- Students will have opportunities for additional support from school staff as needed.

- Students remain with and instruction provided by their in-building classroom teachers.
- Students will have a regular school day schedule in half-day increments with classes and electives similar to the on-site classroom.
- Students will have live interactive teacher led lessons daily.
- Students will use Google Classroom and Google Meets for classes and live lessons.
- Student work and deadlines are the same as if holding on-site classes. Some lessons may be modified due to the online platform but parents can expect rigor and expectations equal to the on-site classroom.
- Teachers will be available to parents and students daily via email and phone, specific schedule varies by school.
- Students will have opportunities for additional support from school staff as needed.

K-12 PENDLETON VIRTUAL LEARNING ACADEMY (separate registration required)

- 100% online homeschool option.
- Students have local teachers and academic advisor.
- Student may participate and work at a time that works best for their schedule.
- Parent driven, homeschool model available K-6.
- Students have the same access to academic and emotional supports as in-building.
- Students will have a full schedule with dedicated times for teacher check-ins and live support.

ACCOMODATIONS AND OTHER SERVICES

- Students receiving special education services will work with IEP team to determine at-home service options.
- ELL students will continue to receive ELD instruction as part of their weekly schedule.
- A limited number of neighborhood hot spots will be available as well as free Wi-Fi access at various public locations
- All students will have a Chromebook checked out to them.
- Sports and activities will take place according to OSAA and the Oregon Health Authority.
- Technology support will be given to students and families.
