PENDLETON VIRTUAL LEARNING ACADEMY

Pendleton Virtual Learning Academy (PVLA) is a K-12 online program partnered with IMESD and is taught by local licensed certified teachers. PVLA offers the flexibility for students to access their online classes at anytime during the day. Students must check-in with their teacher(s) at least twice per week to maintain eligibility.

Any PSD student may enroll in the program and still participate in athletics and extracurricular activities. PVLA K-8 students will check-out a Chromebook from the District Office and 9-12 will check-out from the High School.

The program start date is September 8, 2020 and will end May 28, 2021

K-6 students will be using Ready Math and Ready Reading along with Google Classroom for Social Studies, Science, PE and Music. The IMESD has hired the following certified teachers:

7-8 students have the option to enroll in either Acellus or Google Classroom classes. 7-8 students have the ability to enroll in PVLA courses and take electives at Sunridge Middle School. Teachers are from our IMESD region, we even have some PSD staff contracting to teach courses!

K-8 students may transfer from PVLA back to the traditional classroom and vice versa at any time. We ask that families notify us at least 72 hours in advance of the transfer.

PVLA families will be using ParentVue to check on grades from IMESD teachers.
