

Pendleton School District Reopening 4.0

Stage 1: (Mandated by order of Governor Brown)

- Comprehensive Distance Learning (SeeSaw K-2/Google Classroom K-12/Synchronous) K-12 five days a week.
- Staff will report to buildings daily for their duties.
- Cleaning protocols.
- One to one student/staff technology checkout.
- Instructional platforms Seesaw and Google Classroom.
- Attendance and grading is required.
- District researching ability to provide employee childcare partnership options.

Stage 2: (Determined by meeting mandated metrics and requirements)

- K-5 on-site for ½ day either “am” or “pm” five days a week with on-line materials available for students that can’t attend.
- 6-12 Comprehensive Distance Learning (Google Classroom/Synchronous) five days a week with limited students on-site.
- Recommended (products & frequency) cleaning protocols for ALL sites.
- Staff will report to buildings daily for their duties.
- One to one student/staff technology checkout.
- Instructional platforms Seesaw and Google Classroom prepped for K-5 in the event of the need for a quick transition to on-line instruction.
- Attendance and grading is required.

Stage 3: (Determined by meeting mandated metrics and requirements)

- K-5 on-site entire day all day five days a week with on-line materials available for students that cannot attend.
- 6-12 instructional model moves to two cohorts, alternating every other day on-site five days a week with on-line materials available for students that cannot attend.
- Recommended (products & frequency) cleaning protocols for all K-12 sites.
- Staff will report to buildings daily for their duties.
- One to one student/staff technology checkout.
- Instructional platforms Seesaw and Google Classroom prepped for K-12 in the event of the need for a quick turnaround to on-line instruction.
- Attendance and grading is required.

Stage 4: (Determined by meeting mandated metrics and requirements)

- Full return to school

All Stages:

- Continue to use ODE/OHA guidance and work collaboratively with UCoH.
- In every stage, student meals will be provided (summer meal program waivers have been approved thru June 2021).
- Enhanced social distancing will be employed at all sites when staff and/or students are present.
- PPE provided to all staff.
- Stage upgrades may occur on December 1, 2020, February 1, 2021 or March 29, 2021 **or when the circumstances and public health conditions allow a safe transition to do so.**
- All Stages subject to change due to Executive Order or direction of OHA or ODE.
