- *Mentorship* Builds valuable relationships between students and professionals.
- Job Shadow Provides students with a "day in the life" experience of a local professional.
- Work Experience Students get a taste of a particular career field with a short term placement.
- Internships Students gain real-world experience in a longer term job setting.
- **Service Learning Project -** Working with a local community partner to build transferable skills and fill a need in our community.
