







Students meeting state grade-level expectations.




MATHEMATICS

School Goals

Goal #1 – Providing Instructional Excellence. McKay Elementary has developed a "What I Need" room designed for explicit and targeted instruction, implemented district-approved curriculum, and utilized innovative teaching practices and strategies in both reading and math. McKay Elementary provides daily SEL instruction to all students and conducts regularly scheduled MTSS team meetings to ensure that we are meeting the needs of all students. The district implemented an updated SEL screener (DESSA) to ensure precise screening of our students.






